Government Efficiency Enterprise

We represent the Government Efficiency Enterprise, an office that aims to cut down on the inefficiency and redundancy of everyday life. For example, our own name may be abbreviated as GEE for efficiency, or even further as the letter G, for maximal efficiency.

The G was founded in 1980 as part of the Paperwork Reduction Act (44 U.S.C. § 3513), but the Enterprise immediately shuttered itself after identifying itself as inefficient and redundant. The G was reopened in 2003 when government oversight was more prevalent – lower-hanging fruit than the G was ready to fall from the tree.

The G leadership believes Doctor When’s work has the potential to revolutionize our agency’s work, and hope to be present at the unveiling in order to bring these advances to the American public as quickly and efficiently as possible.
