Investigative Status Report on the Chronology of Higher Level Tasks and the Policies of Chronology

The Redundant Extraneous Department of Task and Paperwork Enforcement has become aware of potential oversights in the chronology of higher level Tasks and the Policies of Chronology and is commissioning Project Doctor When to investigate. The following is a record of the initial background work done to create and prepare Exploratory Committees to discuss appropriate actions, investigations, and include all appropriate and relevant forms for a project of this scope.

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Background

The Redundant Extraneous Department of Task and Paperwork Enforcement (Henceforth referred to in this document as REDTaPE) was formed in early 2011 for the purpose of defining Task Policies and Policy Tasks for the Government. The Department was successful in its goals for the 2011 Annual Year and its budget has been increased fifty-fold¹ for the 2012 Annual Year due to [REDACTED]. After over six successful months in their current charter, REDTaPE has re-organized² itself to take on new challenges and is beginning to define new goals for the next year.

Pursuant to the Temporal Accords and Chronological Surveillance Act of 2011, REDTaPE intends to facilitate accurate timekeeping and time-stream event action reporting. This new direction has been authorized at the highest level by [REDACTED]. Its charter, under the Doctor When Project³, will be to oversee all form design, creation, and data management for any and all events related to the management of orderly chrono-particle lifecycles, and uninterrupted time-flow events.

The goal of the involvement of REDTaPE in Project Doctor When is to require all time travelers and time-displaced entities to pre-register with the proper forms, **prior** to entering any event horizon, or timespace anomaly. Violators are subject to [REDACTED] and the relevant sections of the Temporal Accords, which can be referenced pursuant to a data information request Form G4523, attaching appropriate subforms T432, S093, I80980⁴.

Enforcement will be handled by local authorities, and complete cooperation with REDTaPE officials has been mandated by Senate bill 53.9a, paragraph x72, subsection AG1b⁵. Full details of this authorization are easily obtained using Form M9382, if you have proper clearance. All relevant details are sealed under Executive Order BS092, and UN charter number UN9802.
